

## Back to Church – COVID respond

### What it's going to look like

- We will have a limited number of 50 people per service, pre-registration will be necessary.
- Arrive early, the precautions we need to take do take extra time so to help us begin our service on time. Please come early.
- We ask you to wear masks in and out of the building, but you are free to remove them once seated. If you are unable to wear a mask we ask that you be extra diligent in physically distancing yourself from those you did not travel with. We will have worship leaders if you would like to sing. Wearing a mask can help reduce the risk of spreading airborne particles. We encourage the use of masks, though, not mandatory to sing.
- There will be sanitization stations to sanitize before you enter the building.
- We will have in-person waivers to be signed your first service back.
- You will walk through one of the front doors, up the stairs, and up to the last available pew. We will be filing from front to back to limit physical interaction. Please sit with those you came with.
- After the service ends, masks must be on, and we will exit the main doors starting from the back pew.
- We are not to encourage mingling before or after the service so there will be no 'Higher Grounds'

If you are feeling under the weather at all, play it safe and PLEASE STAY HOME. If you have travelled in the last two weeks, PLEASE STAY HOME.
